Unit Aims

- To familiarise children with the class routine

- To develop gross motor skills through miming actions in the songs
- To develop creative skills by making a *Happy Hearts* badge
- To encourage children to cooperate by singing songs and playing games.

Main Attitudes

- Enjoyment of the songs and activities
- Polite behaviour and respect for others
- Development of confidence in what they can do

Main Evaluation Criteria

Children should:

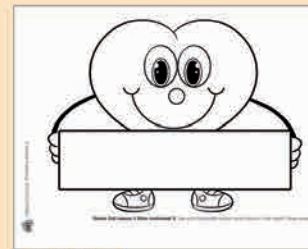
- identify and name the colours red, blue, green and yellow

- respond appropriately to classroom language
- perform actions and mime during songs and games
